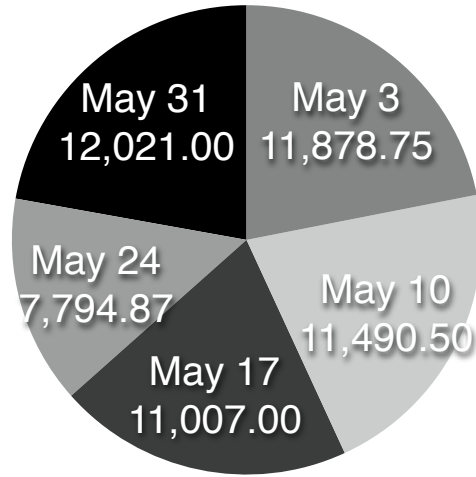
Adult Faith Formation Opportunities

Donation of magazines: Current magazines of good taste. Please place in the basket located on the table in the Gathering area of the Church.

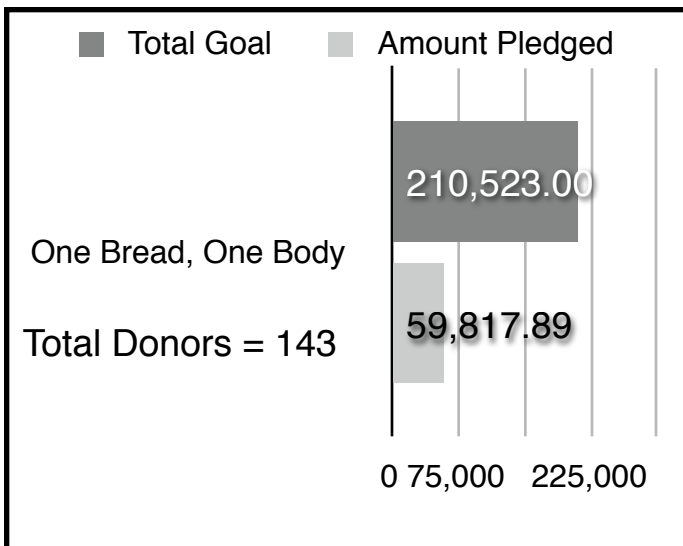
